General Summary:

Adult Halfway House programs provide transitional residential treatment services for adults seeking to re-integrate into the community, generally after short-term or extended residential treatment or incarceration. These programs must provide a structured set of activities designed to develop the living skills necessary for an independent life free from substance abuse outside of a primary residential treatment program. The program must also focus on assisting clients to access or maintain employment as needed.

Target Population:

Males residing in Region V with moderate symptomatology (GAF 31-60), at least two functional limitations, moderate risk of harm to self and/or others, high risk of relapse, and a moderate need for external professional structure, who may need as frequent as weekly service plan adjustments.

Services and/or Frequency of Service / Therapeutic Contact:

Structured supportive living with an emphasis on assessment and treatment planning, education, coping skills for relapse prevention. Programming should include: individual/group counseling, vocational, social skill building, nutrition, and daily living skills.

Staffing Requirements:

Minimum of one CADAC on staff, 50% of all other staff must be CADAC or provisional. A formal written agreement for the utilization of professionals licensed/certified by the Department of Health & Human Services Regulation and Licensure on general medical, psychopharmacology, mental health and psychological issues, as well as overall program design issues, shall be available for consultation.
